

INSTRUCTIONS - FABRIC BAG

- The fabric needs to be approximately 110cm (44") wide and 50cm (20") deep, with another two pieces for handles, approximately 38 cm (15") long.
- Fold the 110 cm (44") length in two and sew the side to be joined and the bottom. If you do not have an overlocking facility on the machine, French seams make the bag strong (i.e. sew with the right side of the material on the outside then turn inside out, sew again to conceal the raw edges, now on the inside).
- Iron the bag to make two fold marks on down the sides. Measure about 10cm (4") at the bottom to make the bag "stand up" on its base. To make this happen, you will need to pull a triangular shape at each bottom side, using the ironed lines as a middle guide on each side. Sew these triangles and press down on the bottom of the bag. Difficult to explain so you should find an example within the kit.
- Neaten the top edge. Make the handles and join to the two top sides of the bag. Oversew where the handle joins the bag to ensure they are strong enough to carry weight.
